
7. AWARD OF CONTRACT

1. The Bidder/ Supplier should possess a valid license for supply of fertilizers in Rajasthan.
2. Submit the valid license/ renewed license within stipulated period of validity
3. All Water soluble Fertilizer grade as per FCO
4. The supply needs to be made in different size of the packing according to the need of the ferti-kit for the particular beneficiary/ crop/ area.
5. Bidder will provide Technical know-how for the foliar fertilization:
6. The technical know-how should be comprehensive in nature and include all aspects/ features/ subjects for successful foliar fertilization with drip or Foliar Spray in different crops in RACP clusters. The interested Agro-consultancy firms/ companies shall provide production related know how technical knowledge in the following manner:
 - a) Will provide technical know-how for successful foliar fertilization techniques, combination of fertilizer, and requirement as per crop/ variety/ growth stages.
 - b) Will provide the operational, agronomical practices and maintenance manual for drip/ foliar fertilization equipment's in Hindi with farmer's friendly language.
 - c) Will provide other information related to successful foliar fertilization technique
